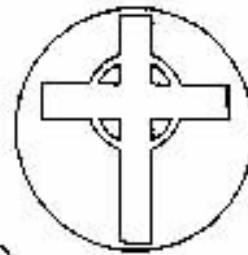
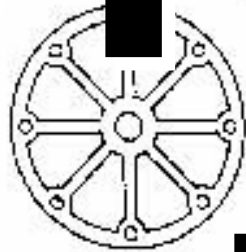

"When the finger points, only the fool looks at the finger."

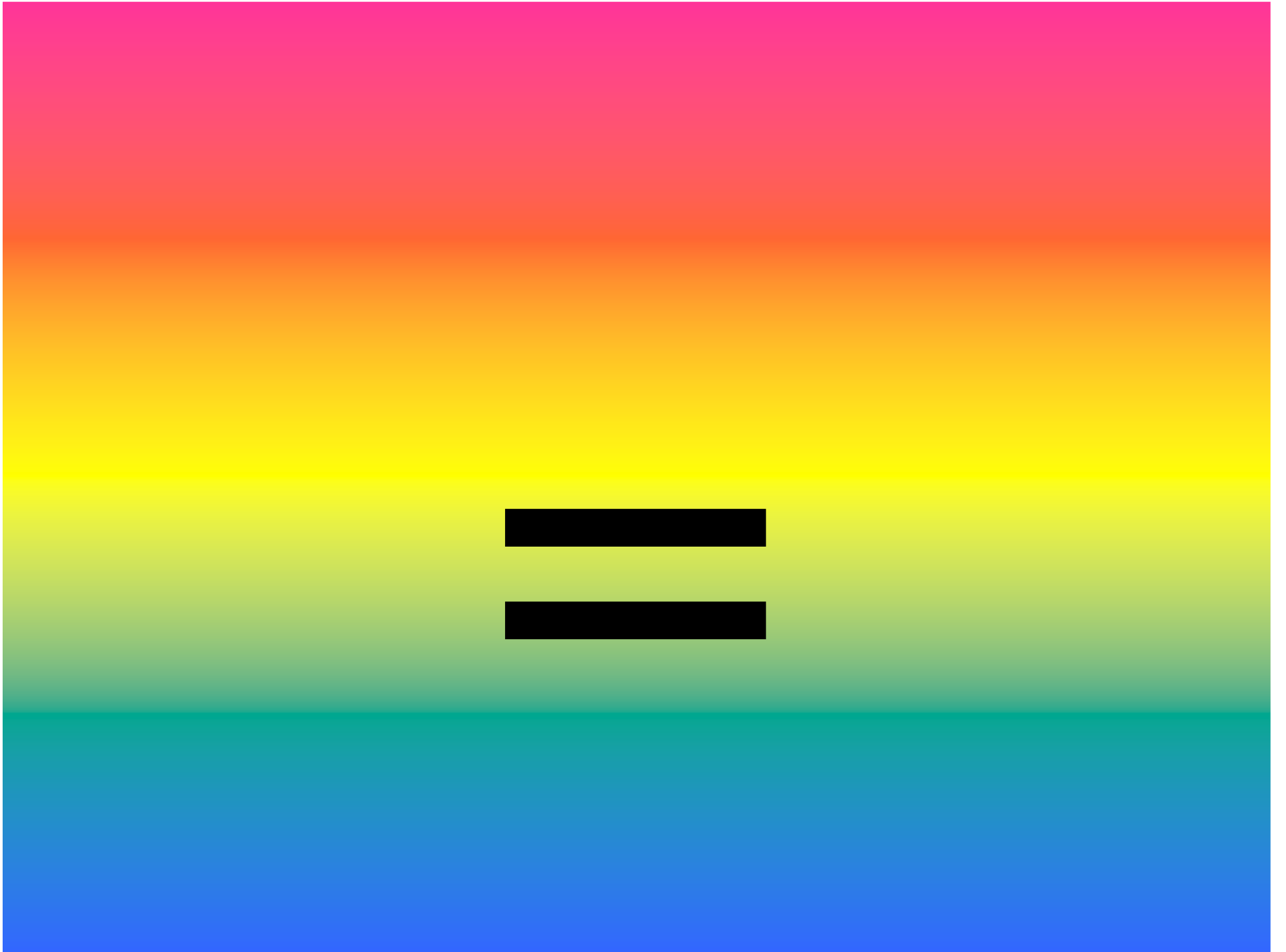
Signs and symbols

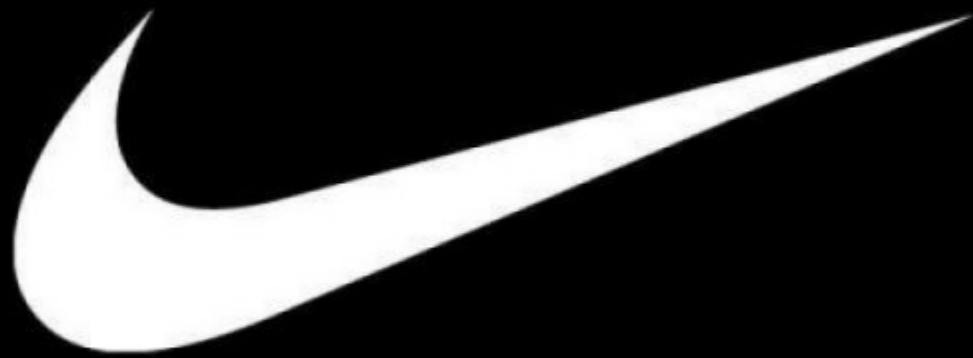

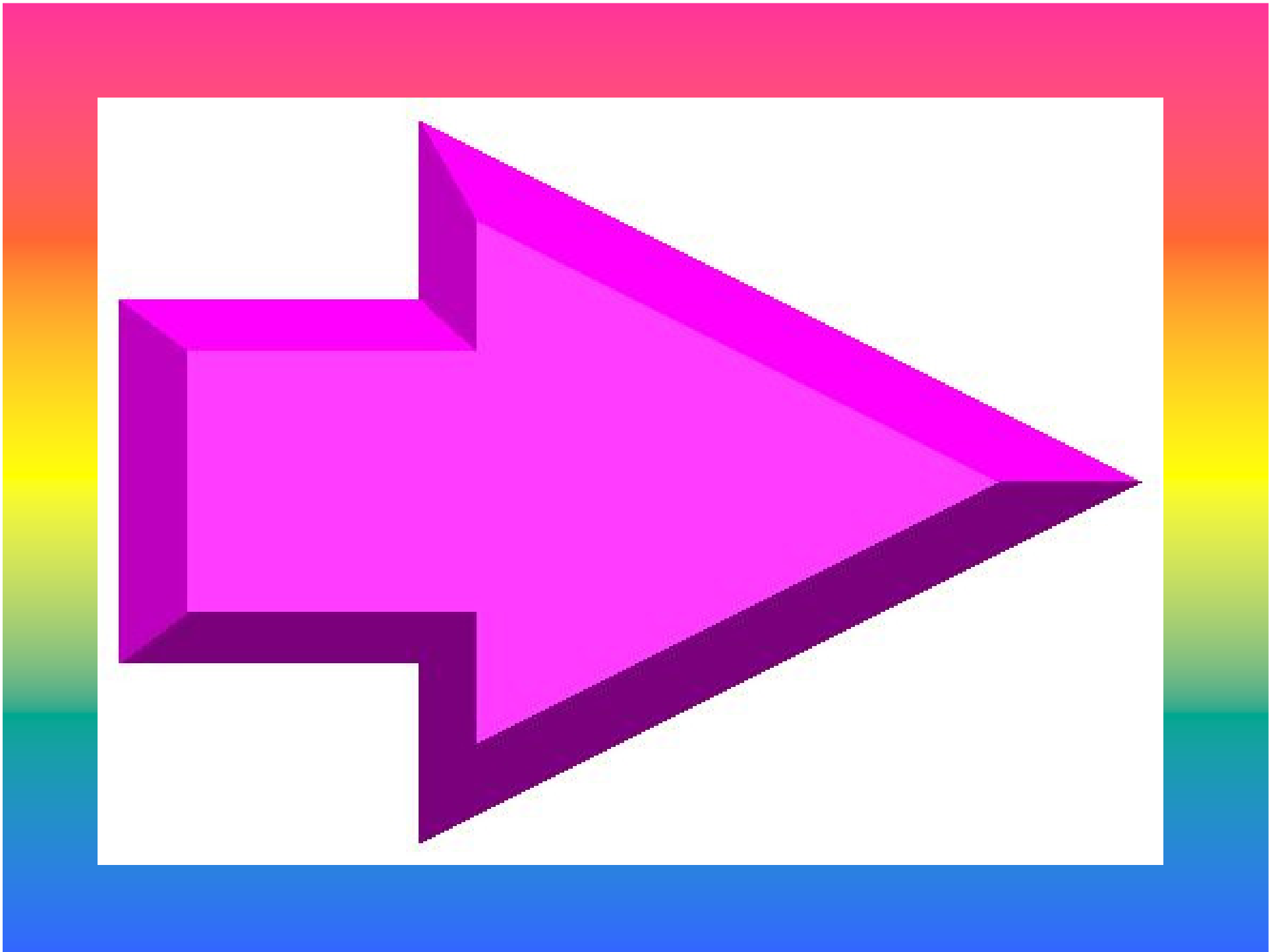


Are signs and symbols the same?

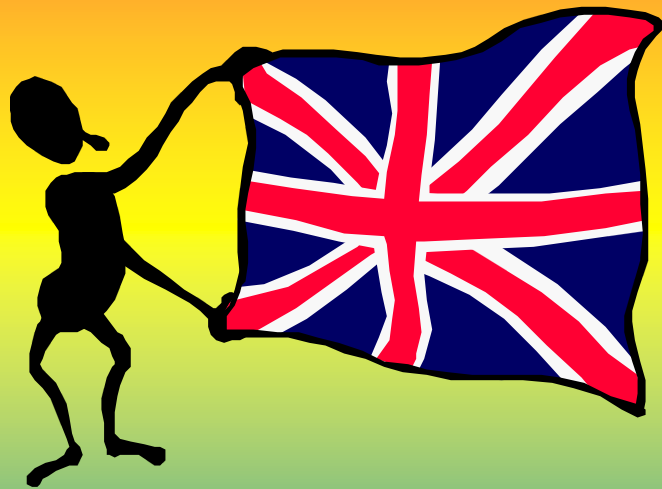
Many of the symbols we have looked at here are also signs but signs and symbols are not the same thing.

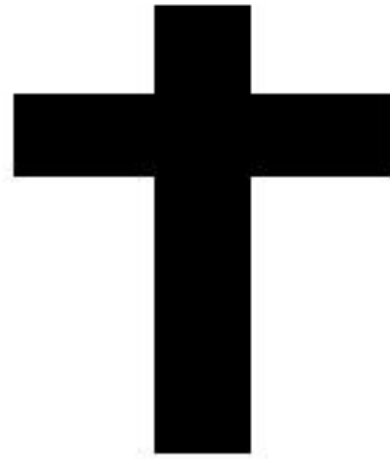
